






2024 Endowed Asset Allocation



The Four Pillars



An endowment was created to support each of the four key pillars of the Catholic Diocese of Utah, by the Board of the Catholic Foundation under former Bishop John C. Wester. Thank you for considering support for one of these endowments (or others) that speak to the ongoing needs within our Diocese.

Pillar One | THE BISHOP'S FUTURE FUND

Utah's Catholic population is growing. The purpose of this endowment is to provide for land purchases for future parish and mission communities, new churches, schools, and facilities and to expand and renovate existing structures.

Pillar Two | THE YOUTH MINISTRY AND EDUCATION ENDOWMENT

The purpose of this endowment is to provide funds for catechetical materials and religious education and to bridge the rising costs of education and the need to provide just salaries for educators.

Pillar Three | SEMINARIAN AND PRIESTLY FORMATION ENDOWMENT

The purpose of this endowment is to provide funds to offset the cost of preparation for the priesthood. The lengthy process of academic study, spiritual life formation, and pastoral skills training costs in excess of \$56K annually for each seminarian. A well-funded endowment aids the Diocesan Vocations Office in its recruitment efforts and ensures those who answer the call will be well-educated and trained throughout their lifetime of church service.

Pillar Four | RURAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT AND MISSIONARY OUTREACH ENDOWMENT


Utah's isolated areas are challenging as work conditions for priests, deacons, and lay people can be daunting. They travel thousands of miles monthly to provide Mass, sacraments, and religious education. Costs are significant and local resources are slim. The purpose of this endowment is to provide funds for transportation needs, including the purchase of vehicles, the acquisition of communication and data processing equipment, and catechetical resource materials.

Eric Heinz spent his K-12 years at the Skaggs Catholic Center in Draper, graduating with honors from Juan Diego Catholic High School in 2011. He subsequently graduated from the University of San Diego with a BS in Business Administration and received a Master's Degree in Sustainable Energy at Reykjavik University in Iceland. Upon graduation, Eric joined Goldman Sachs in Salt Lake City and worked on the derivatives trading team supporting institutional clients.

A natural athlete, Eric excelled at football, lacrosse, and track in high school and then enjoyed many sports, including weightlifting, boxing, hiking, and yoga. He was the captain of the state-champion Juan Diego HS football team and was fortunate to participate in three championship seasons. Eric was a member and officer of the Delta Tau fraternity at the University of San Diego and was active in numerous scholastic organizations while in Iceland.

Eric was a kind and giving soul. He is remembered by all as a man of integrity and kindness.

Disbursements from CFU endowments can help fully fund scholarships for applicants with financial needs.

In 2016, the 100th anniversary of the founding of the Catholic Woman's League, members decided it was essential to continue the legacy and mission of CWL by establishing endowments with the Catholic Foundation of Utah. The CWL was organized under the leadership of Bishop Joseph S. Glass, who suggested the name to emphasize the role of each individual woman. The members, representing many parishes, foster our mission statement by promoting spirituality, educational interests, and philanthropic efforts for our community. A board member represents the Catholic Woman's League on the Utah Legislative Council, and members donate to charitable organizations in the diocese and community each month.



The Cathedral of the Madeleine

A Reflection from The Very Reverend Martin Diaz, Rector

Endowments are an enduring legacy of love. A physical act of appreciation and stewardship. The Cathedral is blessed to have people in the past and present express love for the very building itself. The Cathedral is a tool of evangelization. Every year, hundreds of people come to the Cathedral for the first time. Through what has been called a symphony of colors, people are moved closer to God. People are being drawn into the Catholic church because of the welcome the building itself offers. The parishioners and friends of the past realized the great beauty to be seen in the Cathedral of the Madeleine. They established endowments because they wanted others to experience what they knew personally.

In addition to the day-to-day duties of any pastor, the Cathedral rector is responsible for maintaining and preserving the Cathedral structure. Monsignor Joseph Mayo—then rector of the Cathedral—Laurel Dokos—then Development Director—and Trish Wesson—now Development Director—started the Bishop’s Dinner twenty years ago. The Dinner has provided for the ongoing maintenance and preservation of the Cathedral.

From 2007 to 2013, I was pastor of Saint Therese of the Child Jesus parish. I was a board member of the Catholic Foundation of Utah during that time. Through Foundation events, I met some of the people who had established endowments for the Cathedral. I was grateful for their support of the church. When I became rector and pastor of the Cathedral in 2013, no longer on the board, I experienced firsthand the generosity of the people whose love, gratitude, and vision for the Cathedral continues to this day through their lasting gift of an endowment.



Fr. Anthony Shumway, Parochial Vicar, Cathedral of the Madeleine

I spent my time focusing on an exuberant career, and I achieved that when I was able to work in aerospace inspecting rockets in California. But the excitement eventually diminished, and I began to experience some burnout. I returned home to figure out what to do with my life. I had stopped attending church when I moved out of my parents' house and wanted nothing to do with religion. But when I returned home, my mom made me go to church again. It took less than six months before I knew something was different, and I wanted to spend more time praying. I reached out to the diocese and began the process of discerning if God was calling me to be a priest. I jumped in with both feet and trusted that I would be okay. I thought there was no way they would accept me, but they did. With every excuse I could generate as to why I couldn't make it as a priest, I was put into that situation and shown that I could make it through with the help of God. So, with the grace of God, I am now ordained and serving you all here in Salt Lake.






